A seven-piece tea and coffee service including a tray, coffeepot, teapot, hot water kettle on a stand with a burner, covered sugar bowl, cream pitcher and waste bowl. The design is worked in repousse with flowers and buildings resembling those in a mountain village; there is a hunter with a dog in the scene on the cream pitcher.
