Description

Silver inverted, pear-shaped pitcher with flared rim and spout with band of beading below rim. Cast Cshaped handle decorated with foliage on top and bottom of handle. Body has two die-rolled bands of decoration: one along shoulder with repeating acanthus leaf motif, and one in lower portion of cornucopia. Round, stepped pedestal base has die-rolled band of cornucopia along bottom and floral banding on foot. Centerpunch on underside. "May 21st, 1878" engraved in script on underside.
