**Description**

A silver sugar bowl from a four-piece tea service featuring Classical references in the form of an acorn finial, and acanthus and oak leaves. The bulbous curves of the body are typical of the Empire style and are highlighted by stamped bands of ornament. The sugar bowl has double handles on the sides of the bowl. Inscribed on the side of the bowl are the initials "FR" for Frances Lewis Bolton Richardson (1794-1822). .a - Lid, .b - Sugar Bowl
