One of a pair of silver teaspoons with pointed oval bowls

and fiddle-shaped handle with shoulders. Handles bordered with double threading to end where they form C-scrolls. Raised anthemion in center of upper section of handle ends, acanthus leaves on borders at middle section and raised 10-petal floret at end. Double threading repeated on back of handle and around drop with raised anthemion in center of upper section of handle ends, acanthus leaves on borders at the middle section and raised 10-petal floret at end.
