A porcelain Sevres creamer or cream pitcher from a four-piece tea and coffee service featuring a portrait of Marie Walewska, Napoleon's second wife by artist O. Brun. The creamer is predominantly a striking green color with a band of white hearts around the top. The handle is gold with a series of overlapping white leaves outlined in gold at the base with a gold bird-like creature at the top.
