## Description

A porcelain Sevres sugar bowl from a four-piece tea and

coffee service featuring portraits on both sides of Napoleon's son, Napoléon François Charles Joseph (1811-1832) and, probably, Napoleon's mother, Maria-Letizia Ramolino (1750 - 1836) by artist O. Brun. The sugar bowl is predominantly a striking green color with a band of white hearts around the top. The lid is gold with a bird of prey perched on top. The handles are gold with a series of overlapping white leaves outlined in gold at the base with a gold bird-like creature at the top. .a - Lid, .b - Sugar Bowl
