A twenty-one-piece tea service characterized by a tree and its base leaves in underglaze blue, outlined in gold with orange berries and other leaves formed with gray stems and red dots outlined in gold dots. The tea service is comprised of a teapot, sugar bowl, creamer, waste bowl, dessert plate [saucer], and eight matching teacups and saucers.
