**Description**

An American silver five-piece coffee and tea service with ivory accents. The set includes two teapots, a coffeepot, sugar bowl and cream pitcher. Generally, the pieces tend to have an oval bombe form on a pedestal base with stamped borders of scrolling foliage and flowers. The lids are crowned with a pineapple finial and decorated leaf handles with two bands of ivory.
