Acrylic on board painting of a Black man and a Black woman standing in the gate of a white picket fence in front of a one and a half story house. The woman has white hair and glasses and wears a black jacket, black dress, white gloves, and a gold locket. She holds a black cast iron picket post with her proper right hand. The man wears a gray jacket, white shirt, blue tie, and gray pants, and he holds the woman's proper left arm in his proper right hand. The house has a front porch with elaborate spindle trim in cream across a three-bay façade with green shutters; the roof is red tin with two dormers with ornate trim in the gables.
