### Description

A porcelain Sevres teapot from a four-piece tea and coffee service featuring portraits on both sides of Josephine and Pauline Bonaparte by artist O. Brun. The teapot is

predominantly a striking green color with a band of white hearts around the top. The lid is gold with a bird of prey perched on top. The spout is gold with a series of overlapping white leaves outlined in gold at the base with the opening the head of a large cat, such as a lion. The handle is of the same design as the spout with a gold bird-like creature at the top. .a - Lid, .b - Teapot
