Description

Four-piece porcelain tea warmer consisting of teapot with lid, stand, and burner. Teapot has bulbous body, C-shaped handle, scrolling spout, and elongated base. Body of teapot is painted with bouquets of roses and other pink and blue flowers with green foliage, between lavender garlands, around center and blue flower garlands with lavender sprays near top. Handle and spout gilt. Lid is flat and round with round, gilt finial and single blue and green garland painted near edge. Bulbous stand has slightly

flared round mouth, series of holes around neck, and an arched hole near the base. Body is painted with bouquets of pink roses and other blue flowers against lavender garlands, with blue and green garlands connecting the holes above and lavender sprays between them. Stand has gilt rings around mouth, neck, and base. Burner is small rectangular cup with C-shaped handle.
