### Description

Large urn-shaped porcelain vase with narrow base, wide shoulders, elongated and flared neck, and twisted, curved handles with applied flowers. Front of vase has a gilt oval cartouche topped with shell and coral and surrounded by scrollwork, with a bouquet of pink roses, blue and white daisies, yellow goldenrod, and other flowers and green foliage in the center. Reverse of vase has a thin, gilt scalloped frame with coral motifs on the sides and tops with a bunch of blue convolvulus with white centers and

green foliage, as well as small red flowers, in the center.
