Description

One of three silver teaspoons with oval bowl, swage-formed rounded drop, and fiddle-shaped handle with shoulders. Handles bordered with double threading to end where they form C-scrolls. Raised anthemion in center of upper section of handle ends, acanthus leaves on borders at middle section and raised 10-petal floret at end. "LCW" engraved in script on back of handle.
