Description

One of twelve octagonal plates with a sculptural figure inside an ovoid roundel crowned with a red bow and garland in the center of the plate. Around the edge of the

plate is a gold band with green ovals enclosing a dotted band of gold. In the corners of the octagon are a three-leaved form of vegetation with a gold dotted band extending between each plant. The central motif comprises of a male figure in contrapposto holding an olive branch in his left hand and a scroll in the right.
