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## Sconce

**Description**

One of four sconces with three candelabra arms attached at the base by an Egyptian head mask. The sconce has three semi-circular rings, which define the shape of the sconce with the top band supporting five arched branches covered in crystals terminating in a long prism. Between the rings are strands of small crystals linked together by tiny brass rings. Hanging from the bottom ring and each candelabra arm are a crystal and a prism.
