



## Flat Iron

**Description**  
Iron is pointed at both ends and has a removable handle. The base is hollow for holding charcoal, and there is a spout and a small hole for ventilation. There is a detachable wood handle . The small hole has an iron

cover that features the face of a bearded, old man.
