## Description

Left, one-arm lamp in three-piece chimney garniture. Cut glass font topped with round finial, surmounted with brass prism ring with two flanking dragon heads supporting series of circular and prism-shaped glass drops. Brass foliage scrollwork applied to joint of hub and feeder tube. Brass burner topped with frosted glass shade with flared cylindrical neck tapering to globular base and cut glass prism ring with series of circular and prism-shaped glass drops. Additional cut glass prism ring under hub with series of circular and prism-shaped drops. All on baluster-shaped cut glass base with brass ring surrounding round foot.
