**Description**

A gilt wood architectural mirror or looking glass with an original eglomise glass panel depicting a rural farm scene. The frame is bordered by twin Corinthian columns with spiral center beading; the center plinth with eglomise glass panel supports a high perched eagle holding a chain in his beak. The chain forms a drapery pattern anchored to the points on the pyramidal cornices.
