four children, [The children are Bryan, Isaac, Esther, and Anne.] the youngest sits on the woman's lap; a girl in a white dress is at left and two boys, one in yellow and the other in blue, are at right; the boy in blue holds a hat in front of him and there are three young birds in it; the woman wears a blue dress with white ribbons; there is a landscape background. The position and gaze of 2 of the children indicate that Mr. Morel [who died in 1776]was originally included in portrait on right side.
