Half-length portrait of a young child in a pink dress with white lace around neckline and sleeves and flowers in her hair; she wears a double strand of coral beads tied in back with white ribbon; she holds a peach. It was believed that coral protected children from the "evil eye" and peaches

were a symbol of virtue.
