A George III sterling silver soup tureen with gadrooning, melon-reeding and a monogrammed body inscribed with the initials "LPG JFM" for Louisa Porter Gilmer (1852-1921) and Jacob Florance Minis (1852-1936). The loop handles and foliated finial are of naturalistic forms with the handles terminating in lion's masks. The tureen rests on four scrolled feet. .a - Lid, .b - Tureen
