Description

One of five silver spoons with pointed oval bowls and fiddle-shaped handles with shoulders. Handles bordered with double threading to end, where they form C-scrolls. Raised anthemion in center of upper section of handle ends, acanthus leaves on borders at middle section, and raised 10-petal floret at end. "Soullard" engraved in script in center of middle section.
