An American silver sugar bowl with a waisted body on a circular stepped pedestal. The S-scroll handles terminate in C-scroll stylized griffon's heads. The base and top rims are gadrooned. The domed lid is crowned by an acorn finial surrounded by a radiating leaf motif. Monogrammed on the side of the bowl are the initials, "EYW." .a - Lid, .b - Bowl
