A porcelain teapot from a nine-piece English child's tea set decorated in a blue and white Chinese patterning around the rim with a landscape scene on the body. The teapot is a footed hexagonal vessel with a typical C-scroll handle. The lid is inset into the top of the pot with a ring finial. .a - Lid, .b - Teapot
