Description

Silver pear-shaped chocolate pot with hinging, gadrooned lid with oblong finial, cast C-shaped handle in the form of a branch, and leaf-shaped angular spout with man's bearded face in the front. The top of the pot is engraved with leaves near the rim, and the base has alternating repousse foliage and florals. Footring has two large

moldings. Engraved "JGT" between two leaves in the center of the chocolate pot's side. Small centerpunch on underside.
