### Description

One of twelve octagonal plates with a sculptural figure inside an ovoid roundel crowned with a red bow and garland in the center of the plate. Around the edge of the

plate is a gold band with green ovals enclosing a dotted band of gold. In the corners of the octagon are a three-leafed form of vegetation with a gold dotted band extending between each plant. The central motif comprises of a nude female figure seated on a cloth and rock holding a grape leaf over her head with her right arm.
