Cotton fabrics with a thin cotton batting and muslin back

Description

A pieced quilt in Lone Star and Carpenter’s Wheel Patterns [pattern names originated in 20th-century]. The stars are red and green set within muslin squares on point. The wheels are in blue, yellow, and green appliqued onto alternate muslin blocks. The fabric is quilted in muslin with half inch grids. Along the edge is a narrow yellow binding.
