A silver-plated hot water urn in a round, melon-shaped body with slanted gadroon borders, spout, and leaf-capped loop handles, the cover with gadrooning and finial formed by a flower, and the whole on a square pedestal base, raised on paw feet. .a - Lid, .b - Urn, .c - Burner, .d - Ring
