Mahogany, pine, maple and brass inlay

Description

A mahogany extension dining table with five scrolled supports mounted on curule-style legs with brass capped feet embossed with eagles set atop castors and under the scroll base, a carved acanthus leaf. The table expands to include five leaves with brass inserts or clamps to secure the leaves. At full length, the table can seat up to twenty individuals. Accompanying the table is a mahogany case for storing the unused leaves. .1 - Table, .2-.6 - Leaves, .7-.14 - Brass Clamps, .15 - Case
