One of two sauce boats with curving rims and shaped mouths, cast D-shaped handles with floral ornament, and three cast ball and claw feet. The body of the sauce boat is decorated with chased and repousse flowers, including roses, foliage, birds, and butterflies. It is engraved "Telfair" in script in the center of the side.
