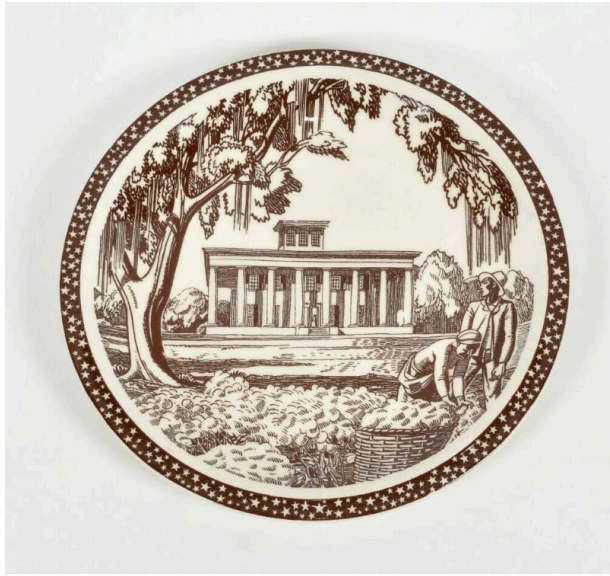




Cotton Pickers, Old South
