Description

Short, silver oviform teapot with hinging, slightly domed lid, cast C-scroll handle, and S-curve spout, on a small round base. Lid has finial in shape of a convolvulus flower, repousse flowers around it, and scalloped edge around rim. Handle and spout cast with raised roses and other flowers. Body of teapot ornamented with repousse roses, daisies and other flowers against dotted background.
