


Figure with candleholder

One of a pair of soft-paste porcelain figural candleholders with cherubs gathering flowers from blossoming trees. This candleholder features a putto with purple hair and wings and a garland and purple patterned fabric around its torso gathering flowers from a tree bearing blue,

purple, pink, yellow, and orange blossoms. A purple bird peers down at the cupid from the tree, and a white dog with brown and black spots sits to one side. The scene rests on a stand of scrollwork and shellwork, painted with green and purple splashes and gilding, and a twisting metal arm projects from the side. The arm is topped with a white flower-shaped candleholder with base, painted with dark blue and gilt flowers and accents.
