### Description

One of two glass vases with opaque white overlay. The flared rim tapers to a thin neck and expands to a bulbous body. The overlay is cut to clear in a series of elongated lozenges with lobed ends around the neck, a series of trefoils around the shoulders, and a series of lozenges with lobed ends in almond-shaped outlines around the body. Gilt scrollwork painted between trefoils and other shapes. Gilt stepped circular base.
