## Sideboard

### Medium

Mahogany, maple inlay, pine, poplar, and brass hardware

### Description

Mahogany sideboard with mahogany and maple veneers with four straight, tapered legs across the front and two at the back; serpentine, central long drawer over double doors, flanked by convex single, small drawers over larger drawers; string inlay cartouches with notched corners on drawer fronts, door fronts, and legs; bands of inlay and panels with curved, rounded ends along bottom portion of legs; brass swing handles with oval escutcheons, one on single, small drawers and two on larger drawer; two key holes, one on central drawer and one on double doors; top of sideboard follows curvature of piece.
